Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) - 2022

Year 7 to 13 students will be required to bring a digital device to school to support their learning. This device can be an existing one from home or a new computer, as long as it meets the requirements below. Additional items that will need to be supplied are headphones and a bag or case that provides adequate impact protection. If due to financial hardship this requirement cannot be met, please do not hesitate to contact us to discuss alternative arrangements.

Choosing a device

A wide range of digital devices are currently available, and the College has determined that **Chromebooks** or **Laptops** (Windows or Mac) are the only suitable devices for our students' BYOD needs. Tablets (Android or iPad) are not suitable. The machine supplied must meet all of these essential requirements:

- · It must access WIFI
- It must run Google Apps (this is school's online email and online collaborative document suite)
- A screen 11" or larger
- A physical keyboard (not part of the touchscreen)
- A battery life that will last the school day (a minimum of 5 hours of continuous work)
- Portable

Bringing an **existing device from home is acceptable** as long as it meets the specifications described above.

Purchasing a device

If you do not have a suitable device already, most major stores will offer a range of BYOD bundles. The school cannot purchase bulk deals cheaper than what the major stores currently offer. A complete (budget) bundle can be obtained on hire purchase for just over a \$1 per day. A bundle typically comes with:

- Headphones and Mouse
- Impact protection, e.g. a laptop bag or hard case
- Extended warranties and insurance (highly recommended)

If a device is required for video or photo editing, then a laptop (Windows or Mac) is the recommended option.

The College gets regular flyers from IT companies with offers of BYOD bundles. Contact the school office (office@mackcollege.school.nz) for more details or visit stores such as Noel Leeming, Smith City or Harvey Norman and ask for their BYOD options.
